# Application

## Preparation:

The maximum performance of **TECTYL 122-A** can be achieved only when the metal surfaces to be protected are clean, dry and free of rust, oil and mill scale. Avoid direct contact of the product with PVC due to possible material incompatibility.

## **Application:**

**TECTYL 122-A** is formulated to be used as supplied. It is recommended that the ambient and product temperature be 10-35 °C at the time of product application. **TECTYL 122-A** can be applied by airless spray or brush.

# Removal:

**TECTYL 122-A** can be removed with mineral spirits or any similar petroleum solvent, vapor degreasing, hot alkaline wash or low pressure steam. Also Tectyl Biocleaner can be used to remove Tectyl 122-A.

#### Processing

Tectyl 122-A is an easy to apply, elastic, protective underbody coating.

#### **Multiple substrates**

The underbody coating can also be used on different substrates, such as the wooden underside of a camper of caravan.

Tectyl 122-A should be stored at temperatures between 10-35 °C. Mild agitation is recommended prior to use. Due to its composition Tectyl 122-A can be subject to postproduction viscosity changes during storage. Under proper storage conditions Tectyl 122-A can have a shelf life of 36 months minimum.
